Memorial Day

It's the three-day weekend that officially kicks off summervacations... a time for hanging out at the beach, barbecuing, even catching a few laps at the Indy 500. But Memorial Day is also the most solemn American holiday--a day to remember those whomade the ultimate sacrifice, while defending their nation.

In the Civil War, America's bloodiest chapter, over 600,000 soldiers were killed in action. Almost every community in every state suffered the loss of young men. As the war came to an end, mourners in both northern and southern states began placing flags and flowers on the graves of fallen soldiers. The town of Waterloo, New York is officially credited with starting the holiday. On May 5, 1866, its citizens closed their shops and businesses so that everyone

I went out to dinner with my dad, who is one of the most amazing people I know. I put on my personal trainer hat and expressed my concern for him. I told him how if he didn't get serious about this, he is only going to get mushier and become like a big marshmallow! (I knew I could razz him a little bit because my dad has always been a jokester). He said, "Noooo, not a marshmallow!"

I said, "Yes and if you don't want me to start to calling you Mr. Marshmallow Man then you had better do something! And if your body turns into mush because you have

no more muscles from not exercising, you are going to start losing your independence as you get older." He exclaimed, "No, not that!" I said, "Yes, do you want to be in a nursing home in 10 years? People changing your diapers?" He was aghast, "NO! I never want to lose my independence!"

I said, "Well then you better get serious because the life that you are living right now with not being fit, your body is not going to be able to support itself as it gets older and you will not have your independence, you will have to have other people taking care of you. Is that what you want?"

I knew it was NOT what he wanted because he is a very independent man and his mother was 95 and still lived on her own when she passed away. He got a more serious look on his face, "No, that is not what I want. Okay, I am serious. Wait till you see me next time!" I said, "Dad, you said that last time I saw you, you need a plan, not just talk." He said, "No, I am really going to do something this time."

So we put a plan together for him. I challenged him to work out at least two times a week for a month and then when he did, he got to buy himself a reward. He decided what his reward was, we shook hands on it and went off on our separate ways. I love him so much and am grateful for him and I don't want to start seeing his body fall apart because he didn't take care of it.

In our world, work is seen as a “necessary evil!” In most cases it is used to define “who I am.” Many believe that the harder you work, the greater the income potential. Well, “they” might believe that stuff, but I don’t and neither do the Scriptures. The Bible teaches several important characteristics, such as “having balance in life” or “being in unity with your spouse.”

Here are several passages about “Work.”

We are his workmanship (Eph. 2:10), finish His work (John 4:34), whatever you do (Col. 3:17-23)! Be not weary (Gal. 6:7-8), do all to the Glory of God (1 Cor. 10:31)!

Dr. Ken Boa summarizes the theology of work: Work is not a result of the fall.

Work is a part of God’s created order for humanity. (Gen. 2:5, 15)

Jesus accomplished the works of His Father. (John 4:34; 5:17; 5:36; 10:32-37; 14:10-13; 17:4)

The Father gives us work to accomplish during our earthly sojourn. (Acts 13:2; 1 Cor. 16:10; Eph. 2:10)

God has appointed us over the works of His hands. (Gen. 1:27-28; Heb. 2:7)

We are called to please God by bearing fruit in every good work. (Col. 1:10; Heb. 13:21)

Our work will be tested and rewarded by God. (1 Cor. 3:13-15)

Scripture rebukes idleness and sloth and affirms that work has genuine value. (Eccl. 2:24; 3:12-13; 5:18)

There is dignity in manual as well as mental work, as is evident from the occupations of the characters of the Bible.

When we seek to glorify God in whatever we do (1 Cor. 10:31), we will pursue excellence in our work, whether others notice or not.

I want to conclude with these thoughts: Work puts us in an environment where we can exhibit Kingdom values.

Work provides a context where we can represent Jesus Christ by building, demonstrating, and being in relationships with others.

God is not impressed by or dependent on our abilities or accomplishments.

There should be a rhythm between work and leisure in our lives so we can enjoy periods of refreshment, renewal, restoration, and relationships.

Spiritual work becomes secular when done to please and impress men.

Secular work becomes spiritual when done to glorify God.

And that is when we will hear, “Well done, good and faithful servant.”

Why Does the Red Cross Discourage Donations of Collected Goods For Disasters?



On April 16, 2016, a 7.8 magnitude earthquake struck the coast of Ecuador in the province of Esmeraldas, some 100 miles from the capital, Quito. The Ecuadorian Red Cross immediately responded, activating 800 volunteers to provide first aid and search and rescue for survivors. The International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC) has pre-positioned disaster relief stock in Ecuador and is providing support to the Ecuador Red Cross through its Americas regional network. It occurred just days after two deadly earthquakes struck Japan’s Kyushu region.

The people of Japan are also reeling from the disaster there when two earthquakes occurred within hours. The Japanese Red Cross immediately responded, dispatching 12 medical teams to help the injured. Additional volunteers are distributing blankets, sleeping mats, tarps, pillows, and hygiene kits to people in shelters as well as other support as needed.

In response to international disasters, the American Red Cross often experiences an outpouring of generosity from the American people. As long as disasters continue to happen, we know that people will want to find ways to help. In addition to tremendous financial support, we typically receive myriad offers of products from individuals and community groups.

If you are an individual or community group who would like to make a product donation (such as clothing, hygiene products, medicine or food), please understand, though your generosity is sincerely appreciated, the American Red Cross cannot accept this type of donation.

Though unsolicited offers of goods and services from individuals and community groups are well intentioned, they have hidden costs and pose a number of complications for relief efforts.

For these reasons, the American Red Cross is unable to accept any large collections of items, such as clothing, hygiene items, furniture, toys, blankets, canned goods, or medicine. We are also unable to accept small individual donations of these items.

Why does the Red Cross discourage donations of collected goods and individual items for disaster relief?

The cost of processing and transporting these types of donations often outweighs the

significant economic loss, purchasing relief supplies in or close to the disaster site also helps to stimulate the devastated economy.

Does the American Red Cross ever accept in-kind donations for international disaster response?

Because of the strict nature of the product selection process, as well as the uniformity requirements when providing relief items internationally, most offers of in-kind cannot be accepted.

If you represent a corporation that would like to offer a bulk donation of items for a Red Cross international response that you sell or manufacture, you may contact your local Red Cross chapter, which will direct your call appropriately. Please keep in mind that due to the time sensitivity, transportation costs, and the complex nature of product needs, we have the greatest success procuring products as close to the disaster site as possible, which avoids delays in getting basic necessities to disaster victims.

What is the best way I can support the relief efforts?

We are especially appreciative of the financial contributions made by individuals, corporations, and foundations. However, the American Red Cross is unable to fundraise for disasters outside of the U.S. if we have not been asked. Please visit www.redcross.org for updated information.

You may also sell your items online to turn your excess stuff into cash in support of the American Red Cross. Both eBay Giving Works and the Web Thrift store allow you to donate a percentage of the final sale price of your items to American Red Cross Disaster Relief.

The American Red Cross has a long-standing partnership with the Ecuadorian Red Cross and has been working in the country for years, helping kids and communities prepare for earthquakes. See more here. Our hearts go out to the people of Ecuador.

cost of the donated items themselves. Donations of collected goods require time, money, and personnel to accept, clean, sort, and distribute them.

The influx of unsolicited donations distracts relief workers on-site from critical emergency response activities—feeding and sheltering the affected population.

In addition, because we cannot anticipate what these spontaneous donations of collected items will include, we cannot ensure that the donated products will be appropriate for the relief effort or that there will be enough of a particular item to distribute them equitably.

Shipping donated goods is costly and particularly difficult in the aftermath of a disaster. Routes into disaster sites are often damaged or impassable and can be clogged easily with shipments of non-priority items.

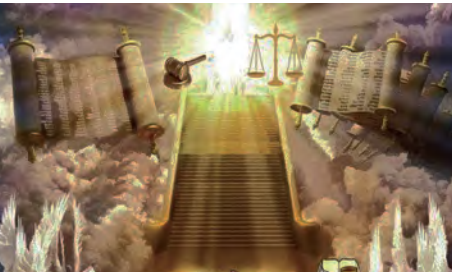
The Red Cross makes every attempt to procure items locally, which minimizes transportation and storage expenses. By procuring goods locally, the American Red Cross can also ensure the items distributed to disaster victims are appropriate for the culture and diet.

could decorate the graves of the men killed during the war. Then an old war general had an idea. John A. Logan, leader of the Union Veteran Association, spearheaded an effort to unite all the decoration services into one national holiday, designating May 30th as Decoration Day. On the first national Dec- oration Day in 1868, 5,000 war widows, orphans, and other mourners gathered at Arlington National Cemetery. They placed flowers and ribbons on the 20,000 graves of both Union and Confederate soldiers. Two future Presidents and fellow Union veterans, Ulysses S. Grant and James A. Garfield, at- tended the ceremony.

Throughout the 19th century, Decoration Day grew. Ceremonies were held in major Civil War battlefields like Gettysburg, Penn- sylvania and Antietam field in Maryland. By the end of the century, the holiday was re- named Memorial Day.

But war wounds ran deep; most southern states refused to commemorate a holiday they regarded as honoring Union soldiers. So each state commemorated their war dead with different Confederate Decoration Days. Several southern states continue the

tradition to this day.

WWI ushered in the age of modern war- fare. America lost over 130,000 soldiers in the global conflict. This shared experience finally bonded America's north and south. When the war ended, May 30th became a day to honor all American soldiers who died in battle as far back as the Revolution- ary War. America interred its first Unknown Soldier in Arlington National Cemetery on Armistice Day in 1921.

Every Memorial Day, this soldier and other unknown soldiers are honored with a wreath-laying ceremony conducted by the President or Vice President.

They are reminders of all those who've never made it home. Memorial Day became a federal holiday in 1971, when Congress shifted it from May 30th to the fourth Mon- day in May, giving federal workers a three- day weekend.

All across America, veterans and civilians still gather in parades and vigils to remember the generations who gave their lives for their nation's freedom.

His point was, if the widow could get a verdict from an unjust judge, how much more we can receive coming from a righteous Judge, a Judge of all the Earth that can render verdict in our behalf?

The Bible says we are seated together with Him in heavenly places, and when you read Hebrews 12:22-24 it actually explains somewhat, that we have come to Mount Zion and the city of the living God.



Then it talks about the Judge, the mediator of the New Covenant, and the blood that

verdict in her behalf to be done here on earth.

The good news is the spirit knows all things, and the demons know who has the authority and who doesn't. Hebrews 4:13 says, "Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and lay bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account." This means you cannot fake the spirit realm. In 1 Peter 5:8 it says "Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour."

Adversary is a Greek word (antidikos) which means one who brings a lawsuit. It's made up into two parts, anti - dikos. Anti = against and dikos = rights. The purpose of the lawsuit is to deny what is rightfully yours.

We wonder why we are not getting what the Bible says and everything Jesus did for us. It's because the Devil has a case against us in the courts of heaven. When we learn how to come into a realm of holiness and repenting, and to understand that the grace of God doesn't give us license to sin. It empowers us to live above sin, so that we can take our rightful position in the courts of heaven and see God's will be done.

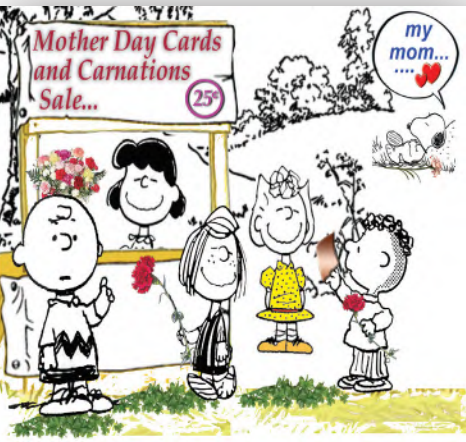
