Who Do You Believe?

History is replete with political, military and religious leaders who have made claims to a position of deity and have, at times, successfully convinced those they led to believe their claims. What makes someone believe that another person is either God or His representative?

The answer to that question varies. Great accomplishments, supernatural feats, superior ideas are presented as proof that God has arrived. But how can we know what is true?

When the apostle Paul was writing the letter to the Romans, he began with a very important statement, "and [as to His divine nature] according to the Spirit of holiness was openly designated to be the Son of God with power [in a triumphant and miraculous way] by His resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord." (Romans 1:4 AMP)

Paul is saying that the proof that Jesus is the Son of God and the Lord of all is the resurrection from the dead.

Jesus often expressed to his disciples and to the multitudes that he would die, but after three days he would rise again. The greatest miracle ever recorded was when Jesus rose from the dead. This was not just a resuscitation of life, for Jesus had raised people from the dead as did some of the prophets of old, but Jesus was resurrected from the dead. What is the difference? If someone is raised from the dead, they will die again. Their body is mortal and therefore they will, one day, die. But resurrection is not raising up what is mortal and temporary but eternal. Jesus was raised to die no more. Jesus said that no one could take his life from him, that only he had power to lay it down and power to take it up again (John 10:18). His resurrection from the dead showed all humanity his prediction was true and his victory over death had been accomplished.

Jesus is the Lord of all creation. The Bible tells us that everything was created by him, "For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him." (Col. 1:16)

But why would the Creator of all things choose to die? Death was the outcome of man's sin and Jesus was a sinless man, therefore death had no right to him or power over him. But man had a terminal disease for which he had no cure. He could only receive the righteous judgment for his sin and that was the same for everyone – death would be the ultimate end of man. Man's destiny was sealed and his ability to change it was lost.

That is why the Lord of All and the Creator of all things intervened. Death could not be denied because death was God's predetermined judgment for sin, and all mankind had sinned. But if God became man and lived without sin, then death could not touch a sinless man. But a sinless man could choose to die and receive the judgment of the sinful and fulfill the righteousness of God. His death would pay the price for sin and all of mankind could receive forgiveness and cleansing from sin by coming to the only one who has the authority to forgive sin and to give eternal life. Jesus defeated death, and as victor he can give eternal life to all who believe. As we celebrate the empty tomb, we are celebrating Christ's victory over death and proof that He is Lord of All, the Son of God, and the only Savior of man.

Most Christians understand very little of its meaning, purpose, and the true importance of the Ark. Many have only heard of it through Bible storybooks. And yet it is so much more than a story. Therefore, we will examine the many facets dealing with the characteristics of the Ark of the Covenant, which is a rather intriguing and mysterious artifact because it point to the image and likeness of Jesus Christ.

The Ark of His Covenant is the focal point that God had established for the Israelites under



the Old Covenant of the Law. When Moses returned to Mount Sinai, it was the Ark that was spoken of first, and then the entire instruction for the Tabernacle after which the last the two tablets was then handed to Moses to be placed in the Ark/Coffin/Throne.

Its main purpose was to make them aware of His presence in the midst of them. All the things that surrounded the Ark, such as the Tabernacle, the priests and their garments, the seven feasts, and all the sabbaticals leading up to the Year of Jubilee were to contribute to this same purpose, and that was to experience His presence in the midst of them. To make certain that the Ark remained the focus, God saw fit to have the Tabernacle in the wilderness built expressly to house the Ark.

Daniel 9:24 "Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish

the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy."

In the end of the age, God will anoint once again the Most Holy. What had happened in the days of Jesus was already fulfilled, but what is also true is that in the last days, many of the revelations of this "secret place" written in Psalms 91 and several other places will be revealed again.

Preventing and Treating COVID-19 in Children and Teens

We are well aware that adults can contract COVID-19, but, unfortunately, children and teens are also susceptible. However, there are certain precautions we can take to reduce the chance of becoming ill with COVID-19 or the flu.

Wash your hands often, avoid touching your face, limit exposure to people outside the home, and wear masks.

Hand washing should last for 20 seconds. Try to make it fun with your child by singing his or her favorite song while hand washing.

Encourage your child or teen to practice social distancing. Limit the people they are exposed to whenever possible. If you can leave them at home with a family member while you go to the store, then do so. If they must go out in public, they should wear a cloth mask and use hand

Clean and disinfect your home, especially toys, doorknobs, tables, light switches, television remote controls, and, of course, bathrooms.



The Great Florida Outdoors: **Dragonflies vs. Damselflies**

While hiking recently at Moccasin Lake Park in Clearwater, I spotted a flying insect landing on a nearby plant. I was exploring for lichens, one of my new passions, and spotted the little beauty. Was it a dragonfly of a damselfly? How do you tell the difference?

Members of the insect order Odonata include not only the true dragonflies but also the closely related group known as damselflies. The order includes roughly 5,900 species, of which about 3,000 are dragonflies (suborder Epiprocta, infraorder Anisoptera), and about 2,600 are damselflies (suborder Zygoptera).

Here are some key differences to observe between Dragonflies and Damselflies:



Most have eyes that touch, or nearly touch, at the top of the head

Body is usually stocky

Wing shape—dissimilar wing pairs, with hind wings broader at the base

Position at rest-wings held open, horizontally or downward



Eyes are clearly separated, usually appearing to each side of the head

Body is usually long and slender

All wings are similar in shape

Position at rest-wings held closed, usually over the abdomen

Although dragonflies and damselflies share many characteristics, including membranous wings, large eyes, slender bodies, and small antennae, there are also clear differences between dragonflies and damselflies as noted above. After you learn the obvious differences such as eyes, body, wings, and resting position, you should find it fairly easy to tell these wonderful insects apart. When you become a more serious student of the odonates, you can begin to learn the subtle differences in wing cells and abdominal appendages.

Both dragonflies and damselflies can be observed in a wide range of sizes and colors. Damselflies have the widest range of sizes. Wingspans can range from about 3/4 inch (19 mm) in some small species to 7 1/2 inches (19 cm) in larger species. Colors range from dull to brightly metallic hues of greens and blues.

Both dragonflies and damselflies lay their eggs in or near water. Hatched larvae go through a series of molts as they grow. As they move toward the adult stage, they begin predatory feeding on the larvae of other insects and on small aquatic animals. The larvae themselves also serve as an important food source for fish, amphibians, and birds. Depending on the species, larval

dragonflies and damselflies reach adulthood in as little as three weeks or as long as eight years. Although they do not go through a pupal stage, the insects begin to develop wings, which emerge as useable flight organs after the last molt of the larval stage. The adult flying stage can last as long as nine months and is marked by predatory feeding on other insects, mating, and finally laying eggs in water or moist, boggy areas. Adult-stage insects consume large quantities of mosquitoes, gnats, and other biting insects.

On close inspection during my hike, I saw that the wings of the insect were held closed, the eyes were clearly separated, and the body long and slender. A wonderful damselfly.

Where can you find these amazing creatures?

Get out and look for them in the Great Florida Outdoors!

We're able to better identify and solve crimes within Pasco County by forging partnerships with citizens and businesses and working with them to increase public safety. PSO has built these relationships and met the needs of the public through numerous events and outreach programs.

This month, the Pasco Sheriff's Office hosted PSO4KIDS, an event focused on connecting with local kids and community members. The event was held at Elsie Memorial Park in Spring Hill and gave citizens the opportunity to meet PSO deputies. Kids were able to enjoy train rides, a bounce house and even played a game of kickball with PSO members. This event was made possible thanks to the generosity of our community partners, such as Grace Family Church and Shady Hills United Methodist Church.

We continually seek ways in which we can connect with the community and have two Officer Friendlies to aid in that endeavor. Their efforts have helped PSO build community trust and stay informed on community needs. You may see them driving around Pasco or attending local events, like community group meetings or PSO's food distributions. They enjoy interacting with the community and interacting with children.

Making a positive impact on Pasco's youth is paramount to PSO's mission. We're able to reach more of Pasco's youth through various programs, such as Juvenile Choice and PSO's Explorer Post 916.

The Juvenile Choice program is geared towards mentoring youth. It informs them on the real consequences for poor decisions and encourages kids to make strides towards a positive future. Recently, the program has evolved to include mentoring programs that focus on issues kids are seeing today, such as school threats, drugs, and online dangers.

Explorer Post 916 focuses on those between the ages of 14-21 who are interested in law enforcement careers. Members of this program receive training in various topics, including officer safety, report writing, interviewing, traffic stops and more.

Along with our Officer Friendlies and youth programs, PSO also looks out for the livelihood of business owners in Pasco through our Business Crime Prevention program. 



What to Plant

Direct sow Pole Beans, Lima Beans, Okra, Southern Peas (like Black-eyed or Cowpeas), Pigeon Peas, Peanuts, Cantaloupe, and Watermelon seeds into your prepared beds or containers. You can start Collards and Summer Spinach from plants or seed as well right now. The Melon family needs a mound to live on and plenty of room to spread! Pigeon Peas are small "trees" so make sure you have space! Also, don't forget: Sweet Potatoes can grow all summer long!

What Needs Done

Veggies: Fertilize existing veggie plants with a side dressing of fertilizer. We recommend Shell's 3-3-3 Organic for great bio-availability & soil enrichment. Fungus is Among Us! Spray cucumbers, squash, and melons for fungal diseases. Garden Friendly Fungicide is TOPS for attacking the fungus & keeping the surroundings safe - spray tops & undersides of leaves as directed (see our staff for helpful tips!). Got bugs? Try Triple Action Neem Oil, Conserve Naturalyte, or Natural Pyrethrins, depending on what bugs you've got. We can help you get what you need, stop in!

Lawn & Landscape: Fertilize lawns, trees, and shrubs with 16-0-8 fertilizer if it was not done in February or March. Fertilize palms with a palm fertilizer if they were not fertilized in February or March - preferably early in April. Lawns should be treated for Chinch bugs, mole crickets, & fleas if you have pets. If you have patches where grass isn't growing, try seeding with with Summer Rye mixed with grass seed or plugs that match your existing lawn - Rye will fill in until your other seed or plug establishes without spreading or contaminating - nourishes the soil too!
