





The apostle Paul in Acts 27 faced a very similar set of circumstances. Maybe it wasn't a pandemic, but an extraordinary set of circumstances that left him and two hundred

and seventy six men in great peril. He was aboard a ship that was adrift at sea as a violent storm had driven them off course and the wind and sea were dangerously tossing them about. There was no visible sign of the sun or stars for many, many days as the storm kept raging, and eventually they lost all hope of being saved. They had no control over their outcome, remaining in continual suspense and their drifting at sea was leading them to further destruction.

When life causes you to feel adrift, with no end in sight, emotions become fearful and anxious, oftentimes leading you to make very serious decisions that are devastating. Maybe that's how you feel right now. Are you contemplating a decision that would be a disaster for you and everyone else because you are motivated by hopelessness?

Paul, while on this voyage with many sailors, found that they were ready to jump ship and their decision would ultimately cost them their lives. He began to warn them in the midst of this horrific storm that their decision would only bring them more destruction. How could Paul know this?

Why was Paul so decisive about proper direction in the midst of being adrift? Why was he able to take charge of this seemingly impossible situation and bring hope to 276 desperate, starving, fearful sailors? How could he bring such clarity of thought as he did when he said (verse 22) "there would be no loss of life among them." It was because Paul had heard from the Lord!! This tells me that when we feel adrift, no matter how hard the circumstances, we can look to God and listen for His direction. He can and will speak in the most impossible situations. We need but to ask, believing that He will answer.

Paul contended for God's wisdom, he prayed in intercession (appealing to God on behalf of others) and worshipped God despite how he felt in this life-threatening storm. I am reminded that God never leaves us, nor forsakes us and nothing can separate us from His love! Not only did God speak, but He sent an angel to Paul to strengthen him, accompanied with an incredible gift of faith to encourage everyone on this ship that their lives would be saved, even though the ship would be lost, and they would end up on an island. This word of the Lord was delivered with such anointing that all listened and took courage. Can you imagine how powerful the word of the Lord was that impacted those men?

I want to encourage you today that no matter how difficult your circumstances are, no matter what you are facing that seems insurmountable, bringing you the feeling of loss of control and the odds seem against you, take Courage, seize it this very moment. God will impart to you help no matter how far you have drifted.

You need but to call upon Him in time of trouble, trusting him to answer. Then hold on for His answer and help will arrive! You can boldly say, "The Lord is my helper, I will not fear," (Heb.13:6). Take heart today my friend, all is not lost as you think. Your heavenly Father knows what you have need of even before you ask! He has a supernatural impartation of strength to give you to see you through!

In conclusion, Paul's life was spared, and so were the 276 men that were with him. They did



land on an island where they found incredible favor with the people, miracles happened, and God received all the glory!! What a great ending to a horrible journey!!

Preventing and Treating COVID-19 in Children and Teens

We are well aware that adults can contract COVID-19, but, unfortunately, children and teens are also susceptible. However, there are certain precautions we can take to reduce the chance of becoming ill with COVID-19 or the flu.

Wash your hands often, avoid touching your face, limit exposure to people outside the home, and wear masks.

Hand washing should last for 20 seconds. Try to make it fun with your child by singing his or her favorite song while hand washing.

Encourage your child or teen to practice social distancing. Limit the people they are exposed to whenever possible. If you can leave them at home with a family member while you go to the store, then do so. If they must go out in public, they should wear a cloth mask and use hand sanitizer often.

Clean and disinfect your home, especially toys, doorknobs, tables, light switches, television remote controls, and, of course, bathrooms.

As in flu prevention, eating a healthy, well-balanced meal, getting enough sleep as well as plenty of outdoor exercise in the fresh air and sunshine, can help to build your immune system to fight off the illnesses.

If you suspect your child has been exposed to COVID-19, the symptoms can include fever, cough, nasal congestion or runny nose, sore throat, shortness of breath, fatigue, headache, muscle aches, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, poor appetite, new loss of taste or smell, or belly pain.






The Great Florida Outdoors: The Beautiful Snowy Egret

On a recent trip with my niece Michelle and my daughter Fionna to the Wakodahatchee Wetlands in Delray Beach, I was fortunate enough to photograph wood storks, egrets, green herons, and a great many other marvelous creatures. The snowy egret is in the family of Herons, Egrets, and Bitterns.

The snowy egrets are medium-sized herons with long, thin legs and long, slender, bills. Their long, thin neck sets the small head well away from the body. Adult Snowy Egrets are all white with a black bill, black legs, and yellow feet. They have a patch of yellow skin at the base of the bill. Immature Snowy Egrets have duller, greenish legs.

Their habitat includes marshes, swamps, ponds, and shores. The bird is widespread in many types of aquatic habitats, including fresh and salt water; in coastal areas, and may seek sheltered bays. Inland, a snowy egret favors extensive marshes and other large wetlands but sometimes forages in dry fields.

It nests in colonies in trees, shrubs, mangroves, sometimes on or near the ground in marshes. The females usually have 3-5 eggs, pale blue-green. Both parents feed the young. The last young to hatch may starve. Young may clamber out of the nest after 20-25 days of incubation, probably unable to fly before 30 days. Male and female Snowy Egrets take turns incubating their eggs. As one mate takes over for the other, it sometimes presents a stick, almost as if passing a baton. Both parents continue caring for the young when they hatch.

During the breeding season, adult Snowy Egrets develop long, wispy feathers on their backs, necks, and heads. In 1886 these plumes were valued at \$32 per ounce, which was twice the price of gold at the time. Plume-hunting for the fashion industry killed many Snowy Egrets and other birds until reforms were passed in the early twentieth century. The recovery of shorebird populations through the work of concerned citizens was an early triumph and helped give birth to the conservation movement. With protection, populations recovered. In recent decades, it has an expanded breeding range far north of historical limits. It is probably still expanding in range and increasing population.



I was able to capture a lovely bird, sporting a vibrant green lore—the area between the bill and the eyes—indicative of the breeding season. As noted, the bird will also display long, elegant plumes on its back shown here which are used in courtship displays. Like a peacock, the feathery plumes spread out like a fan. After the breeding season, these long feathers disappear.


Adult Snowy Egrets have greenish-yellow feet for most of the year, but at the height of the breeding season their feet take on a much richer, orange-yellow hue. The bare skin on their face also changes color, from yellow to reddish.

Snowy Egrets sometimes mate with other heron species and produce hybrid offspring. They have been known to hybridize with Tricolored Herons, Little Blue Herons, and Cattle Egrets.

Snowy Egrets wade in shallow water to spear fish and other small aquatic animals. While they may employ a sit-and-wait technique to capture their food, sometimes they are much more animated, running back and forth through the water with their wings spread, chasing their prey. I recommend you subscribe to this web site for the American Bird Conservancy at abcbirds.org. You will get sent a weekly newsletter to learn your birds! Where can you find the beautiful Snowy Egret?

He finally discovered his oldest son, Joshua, in a corner sobbing and praying. "Josh, tell me it's not true." Joshua turned to his dad and said, "It's true. Today David was not strong enough to do his work and so they took him away."

Mr. Rosenberg then asked, "But where is your mother?" Joshua could barely speak and finally uttered, "When they came for David, he was afraid and cried and so mom took his hand and went with him." That's the kind of love that Hannah had for Samuel. You can read about her in the book of 1 Samuel in the Bible. Hannah was willing to sacrifice herself for the sake of her son. She loved him so much that she was willing to forgo a mother's greatest joy-that of bringing up her son and having him around her. She was committed to do whatever it took for him to reach his godly potential.

If you read through the book of 1 Samuel, you will discover that Eli had three sons; Hophni and Phinehas were very evil and did some detestable things. It's very interesting that their mother is never mentioned anywhere.

We don't know if she died or if she was just not engaged as a parent. Samuel, on the other

hand, was greatly impacted by his mother's influence, and went on to become a significant individual in God's redemptive history. Moms, you matter greatly to your kids and to the very future of our world.

Scams to Watch Out For

The Pasco Sheriff's Office receives reports of many different scams throughout the year. Suspects are using these scams to extort citizens and turn them into victims. Because of this, we want to share frequent scams we see for this month's newsletter to make sure that you and your family are aware and prevent victimization in our community.

Vaccine Scam

The pandemic has made this past year challenging. Unfortunately, this has not stopped criminals from capitalizing on people's fears. A common scam being seen across the country is phone calls to reserve vaccines.

Victims receive phone calls advising they can reserve their COVID-19 vaccine by providing either a credit card number or social security number. These fraudsters are impersonating Centers for Disease Control (CDC) personnel and government officials.

This scam has been occurring since last spring and we may see an increase in these calls as vaccines continue being distributed. We ask that you do not provide any personal information to these individuals as it may be a scammer. Follow only credible sources of information regarding COVID-19 updates.

Church Scam

Victims of this scam are contacted by an unknown subject claiming to be a pastor or church employee. The scammer will make contact through email or phone call and inform the church member to not call the number back, as it would disturb a prayer session. The caller will then ask the victim to purchase gift cards and share the information for the cards by taking a photograph and sending it to them.

If you receive any communication from someone claiming to be affiliated with a church, please reach out to the church office directly and verify this request. Do not share financial information or gift card information via email, phone or text messages.

Threats Via Text Scam

Scammers are sending text messages to random numbers informing the recipient they have been instructed to cause harm to them. The subject offers the victim the chance to prove how important their life is by allowing them to pay instead of being harmed.

If you receive a text or phone call regarding these threats, please do not engage in conversation or provide any personal information.

As always, if you or someone you know has been a victim of these scams, please report them to the Pasco Sheriff's Office at 727-847-8102 option 7.





May Garden Tips

Your Monthly Garden To-Dos from your May, more than any other month of the year, wants us to other month of the

year, wants us to feel most alive. What to Plant -- Fennel Hudson

It's not a long list right now! Sweet Potatoes, Swiss Chard, Okra, Southern Peas (such as blackeye peas, zipper cream peas, pinkeye purple hull peas, etc) are your best bets for this time of year.

Seeding for Summer Cover Crops, if you're not growing any of the above, is a great idea this month, those include southern peas mentioned above, Sunn Hemp, Marigolds, Buckwheat, fava beans, and more.

If you have seedlings for anything from the April Garden Tips list, get them in the ground right now!

What Needs Done

Edibles/Veggies: Fertilize Citrus Trees now with nothing higher than an 8-8-8 for trees age 1-4, & 4-6-8 for trees 5 years & older, following instructions on the citrus fertilizer bag for fertilizer placement & amounts. Fertilize existing veggie plants with a side dressing of fertilizer like Shell's 3-3-3 Organic for great bio-availability & soil enrichment. Add Dolomitic Lime/Ag Lime to your nightshades (tomatoes, peppers, etc) to keep blossom end rot at bay. Fungus is a problem in Florida! Spray Garden Friendly Fungicide on cucumbers, squash, & melons for fungal diseases & keep the surroundings safe - spray tops & undersides of leaves as directed (see our staff for helpful tips!). Got bugs? Try Triple Action Neem Oil, Conserve Naturalyte, or Natural Pyrethrins, depending on what bugs you've got.

Lawn & Landscape: ATTENTION! THERE IS A FERTILIZER BAN THAT STARTS JUNE 1 FOR NON-AGRICULTURAL/FOOD PRODUCTION USE. NOW IS THE TIME TO FERTILIZE IF YOU HAVEN'T ALREADY!

Fertilize Palms with specialized Palm Fertilizer to avoid yellow frizzle & browning of fronds. Control black spot on roses & other plants with sprays made for that purpose. Green up your lawn by aerating & spreading Milorganite, allowing the rain to water it in for you if possible. Use Hydretain in all your watering to reduce
