Preventing and Treating COVID-19 in Children and Teens

We are well aware that adults can contract COVID-19, but, unfortunately, children and teens are also susceptible. However, there are certain precautions we can take to reduce the chance of becoming ill with COVID-19 or the flu.

Wash your hands often, avoid touching your face, limit exposure to people outside the home, and wear masks.

Hand washing should last for 20 seconds. Try to make it fun with your child by singing his or her favorite song while hand washing.

Encourage your child or teen to practice social distancing. Limit the people they are exposed to whenever possible. If you can leave them at home with a family member while you go to the store, then do so. If they must go out in public, they should wear a cloth mask and use hand sanitizer often.

Clean and disinfect your home, especially toys, doorknobs, tables, light switches, television remote controls, and, of course, bathrooms.

As in flu prevention, eating a healthy, well-balanced meal, getting enough sleep as well as plenty of outdoor exercise in the fresh air and sunshine, can help to build your immune system to fight off the illnesses.

If you suspect your child has been exposed to COVID-19, the symptoms can include fever, cough, nasal congestion or runny nose, sore throat, shortness of breath, fatigue, headache, muscle aches, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, poor appetite, new loss of taste or smell, or belly pain.



Women Are Making Disciples Through The Well Training Ministry



Social Security Benefits Increase In 2022

Approximately 70 million Americans will see a 5.9% increase in their Social Security benefits and Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payments in 2022. Federal benefit rates increase when the cost-of-living rises, as measured by the Department of Labor's Consumer Price Index (CPI-W).

The CPI-W rises when inflation increases, leading to a higher cost-of-living. This change means prices for goods and services, on average, are a little more expensive, so the cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) helps to offset these costs.

We will mail COLA notices throughout the month of December to retirement, survivors, and disability beneficiaries, SSI recipients, and repre-

sentative payees. But, if you want to know your new benefit amount sooner, you can securely obtain your Social Security COLA notice online using the Message Center in your my Social Security account at www.ssa.gov/myaccount. You can access this information in early December prior to the mailed notice

If you prefer to access your COLA notice online and not receive the mailed notice, you can log in to your personal my Social Security account at www.ssa.gov/myaccount to opt out of a mailed COLA notice and any other notices that are available online by updating your Preferences in the Message Center. Did you know you can receive a text or email alert when there is a new message waiting for you? That way, you always know when we have something important for you – like your COLA notice. If you don't have an account yet, you must create one by November 17, 2021, to receive the 2022 COLA notice online.

January 2022 marks other changes that will happen based on the increase in the national average wage index. For example, the maximum amount of earnings subject to Social Security payroll tax in 2022 will be higher. The retirement earnings test exempt amount will also change in 2022 and you can view that at www.ssa.gov/news/press/factsheets/colafacts2022.pdf.

Be among the first to know! Sign up for or log in to your personal my Social Security account today. Choose email or text under "Message Center Preferences" to receive courtesy notifications. You can find more information about the 2022 COLA at www.ssa.gov/cola.

Gift Card Safety

Gift cards are both highly requested and convenient for holiday shoppers. Some retailers offer gift cards digitally, removing the physical card. Unfortunately, with all the positives, gift cards create an ideal opportunity for scammers. The Pasco Sheriff's Office wants to help you spot and avoid potential gift card scams this holiday season.

Carefully inspect gift cards before you purchase a balance on them. A scam often starts before a card is activated. Gift cards stored near the register and under security camera coverage are less likely with which to be tampered. Carefully review cards and packaging for signs of tampering or exposure. Scammers can take a photo or write down card numbers and check the balance later, searching for cards with an activated amount. If the PIN is exposed on a gift card, notify a store representative and choose an untampered card on which to load funds. Be mindful of replacement stickers that may cover security codes, look for scratches to the card beyond the security strip.

Buying gift cards directly from the retailer and online purchases are best. Direct purchases require fewer transfers of funds resulting in more stringent security. Online retailers mail the gift card directly to you, preventing any access to the purchase codes and PIN. In addition, your receipt from the retailer for the gift card has a direct verification to validate your purchase. As a bonus, stores sometimes offer incentives when you purchase a specific amount. Never buy gift cards from an auction or community website. Resale sites are often a traffic source for stolen, fraudulent or already used gift cards.

Save receipts after the purchase of a gift card. Consider taking a photo of your receipt. You can email that photo to yourself for record-keeping if you fear you may lose the receipt. If you fall victim to a scam, your receipt can validate the original ownership and value of the gift card. In addition, the company's direct purchase of a gift card offers enhanced transaction information such as purchase location, activation and any use of the gift card.

If you receive a gift card, treat it like you would a debit card. Using a gift card quickly helps eliminate potential threats. Change the security code as quickly as possible to something unique only you will know. Check the company's website to see if you can create an account. This feature can help protect your credit value as well as the risk of misplacement or theft. If available, register your gift card online with the company. Some large retailers realize the potential lost or stolen gift card and the opportunity to combine the balance of several cards onto one. At the same time, when you register your gift card, check for the availability to report a scam online through the retailer. Online fraud reporting will avoid a long wait on the phone to speak with the fraud department and easily save confirmation or claim numbers.

Taking a bit of extra caution with your gift cards this holiday season will help prevent gift card scams. Follow Pasco Sheriff's Office social media pages for the latest updates and safety information. PSO wishes you a safe and happy holiday season!

The Great Florida Outdoors: Ecotones

While hiking with my friend Ed along Cowhouse Creek, we noted a very clear transition between hardwood forest and the land bordering the creek. The forest land was filled with maples, pines, palmettos and sabal palms on high and dry land. We also saw fences and barbed wire, indicating the land had probably been used previously as a ranch or farm.

The land near the creek was muddy

and populated with cypress knees and exposed cypress tree roots. We located several water locust trees (Gleditsia aquatica). The water locust or swamp locust has a habitat on river swamps and slough margins. It is a tree native to the Southeastern United States and adjacent regions.

An ecotone is an area that acts as a boundary or a transition between two ecosystems and is of great environmental importance. Because the area is a transition between two ecosystems or biomes, it is natural that it contains a large variety of species of fauna and flora as the area is influenced by both the bordering ecosystems. Most wetlands are ecotones.

Ecotones include marshlands (between dry and wet ecosystems), mangrove forests (between terrestrial and marine ecosystems), grasslands (between desert and forest), and estuaries (between saltwater and freshwater). Mountain ranges can also create ecotones due to the changes in the climatic conditions on the slopes.

An ecotone may be wide or narrow. It has conditions intermediate to the bordering ecosystem or could contain species that are entirely different from those found in the bordering systems.

Ecotones can be natural or man-made. An ecotone between an agricultural field and a forest is a man-made one.

I will outline three distinguishing features of an ecotone. First, an ecotone can have a sharp vegetation transition, with a distinct line between two communities. (1) A change in colors of grasses or plant life can indicate an ecotone. Second, a change in physiognomy (physical appearance of a plant species) can be a key indicator. Water bodies, such as estuaries, can also have a region of transition, and the boundary is characterized by the differences in heights of the macrophytes or plant species present in the areas because this distinguishes the two areas' accessibility to light. (2) Scientists look at color variations and changes in plant height. Third, a change of species can signal an ecotone. There will be specific organisms on one side of an ecotone or the other.

Other factors can illustrate or obscure an ecotone, for example, migration and the establishment of new plants. These are known as spatial mass effects, which are noticeable because some organisms will not be able to form self-sustaining populations if they cross the ecotone. If different species can survive in both communities of the two biomes, then the ecotone is considered to have species richness; ecologists measure this when studying the food chain and success of organisms. The abundance of introduced species in an ecotone can reveal the type of biome or

efficiency of the two communities sharing space. (3) Because an ecotone is the zone in which two communities integrate, many different forms of life have to live together and compete for space. Therefore, an ecotone can create a diverse ecosystem.

What is the edge effect? Edge effects refer to the changes in population or community structures that occur at the boundary of two habitats. Generally, there is a greater number of species found in these regions (ecotones) and this is called the edge effect; the species found here are called edge species.

An ecotone is often associated with an ecocline: a "physical transition zone" between two systems. The ecotone and ecocline concepts are sometimes confused: an ecocline can signal an ecotone chemically (ex: pH or salinity gradient), or microclimatically (hydrothermal gradient) between two ecosystems.

What is the importance of ecotones?

- They have a greater variety of organisms.
- They also offer a good nesting place for animals coming in search of a nesting place or food.
- They serve as a bridge of gene flow from one population to another because of the larger genetic diversity present.
- They can act as buffer zones offering protection to the bordering ecosystems from possible damage. For example, a wetland can absorb pollutants and prevent them from seeping into the river.
- Ecotones are also a sensitive indicator of global climate change. A shifting of boundaries between ecosystems is thought to be due to climate change. Scientists and environmentalists are studying ecotones with greater interest now.
- Ecotones are an extremely important concept in the study of the environment and ecology—environment, climate change, and biodiversity. (4)












Who I Am Foundation - Turning a Tragedy Into a Blessing for Others

Tracy Serdynski Stites and her family never imagined that they would be starting a foundation that would make such an impact on hospital patients, their loved ones, and even the doctors and nurses who care for the

It all began in July 2020. Her father, Don Serdynski, was developing flu like symptoms and went to the hospital. It was determined that he had COVID, and due to restrictions, other family members were not allowed in. Before long, his conditioned worsened. He was placed on a ventilator, which made him unable to communicate with his family as well as the doctors and nurses caring for him.

The only means of communication the family had was through the nurses. Each time a call came in through the nurse's station, a

nurse would put on the protective gear to enter the room and hold the phone up to their father's ear so he could hear their voices. The nurses were doing this for each of their patients. This placed a great deal of burden on the already overworked staff as they had hundreds of patients at the time.

Her father was not getting better as they had prayed, but God blessed them in another way. Their family was allowed to visit their father during the last five days of his life, in a COVID ward in his COVID isolation room.

"This was definitely a God thing, because in the past, we could only see him through a glass window," said Tracy,

One day when Tracy was getting ready to visit her father, she gathered family photos to place in her father's room so that when he opened his eyes, he would know they had been there and enjoy the memories of family trips, his mammoth sunflowers that he loved to grow, and watching the Florida Gators, his favorite football team. She also wrote a note to the nurses asking them to call a family member whenever they were in the room so that the nurse could call when it was convenient. This would alleviate the extra time each nurse took to put on the gear and go into the patient's room, since he or she was already in the room performing his/her routine duties.

As a citrus grower for most of his life, Don Serdynski was very healthy before COVID struck, and they never imagined that he would be taken from them so soon. In the last few days of his life, when hospice took over, one of the workers mentioned that she didn't know of any other family that was able to spend time with their loved one suffering from COVID. Tracy knew it was God's

Knowing that the nurses were overworked and extremely tired, Tracy asked what they could do to help them. Reducing the number of calls to the nurse's station was one request and the second was how much they enjoyed looking at the pictures. It helped them to connect to her father more. They missed that personal connection and wished that other patients had pictures in their room.

"It's a refreshing look into who someone is when they can't speak," one nurse said.

On his last night on earth, Don was being taken care of by Tim Lanier, a nurse, who is also a big Gators fan. Tim called Don's family using the phone number in the room to let them know he was passing. When Tim realized they would not make it in time, he took Don's hand and said "I am not going to let a fellow Gator die alone. I will stay with you until the end." Because of the photos in the room, Tim was able to talk to Don about his family, his flowers and Florida Gator Football until Don went home to be with the Lord.

In her grief, Tracy asked God 'what can we do to help the doctors and nurses and other people going through this tragic time?'

"God spoke to me and said it's the phone number and the pictures in the room."

That's when she came up with the idea to make a Patient Kit. Through Advent Health,

they were able to create patient support kits and "Who I Am Foundation" came into fruition. The kits consist of hospital grade plastic photo pages with pockets that can be used for pictures, notes, and family contact information.




The patient support kits are also used by families with special needs children and in nursing homes for their dementia patients.

December Garden Tips

What to Plant

December is a great time to plant Florida Winter crops like Beets, Broccoli, Cabbage, Carrots, Cauliflower, Celery, Chinese Cabbage, Collards, Kohlrabi, Lettuce, Mustard Greens, Peas, Radish, Spinach, Turnips. Herbs: Basil, Chives, Coriander/Cilantro, Dill, Fennel, Mexican Tarragon, Mint(s), Oregano, Rosemary, Sage, Thyme. As you can see we're focused on Winter crops now! It's a good time also to root cuttings from your best Fall producing plants to overwinter in a warm protected place.

What Needs Done

Edibles/Veggies: Established crops: add a side-dressing of fertilizer (6-6-6 or 8-8-8, or Shell's Organic 3-3-3. Keep up with weeding! Get mulch down if you haven't already to prepare for cooler temperatures coming up. You can plant from seed this month, though with cooler weather they will sprout slower without a little help from a heat pad under your seed cells. Transplant Winter starter plants. Seed potatoes should be in this month, we usually get White Kennebec, Red Pontiac and Yukon gold, so check in with us, and ensure you clear space in your garden for planting potatoes. Adjust your watering down as the days get cooler, plants won't need as much!

Fungus? Use Garden Friendly Fungicide. Caterpillars? Thuricide or Dipel. Aphids/insects? Conserve Naturalyte. Make sure you check out the Blog at ShellsFeed.com/blog and you'll find lots of gardening articles to help you out.

Lawn & Landscape: Fertilize your lawn and landscape to make the most of what's left of the Florida heat. It's a good time to overseed your lawn with Winter Rye for lawns that go dormant in the Winter (like Bahia) at 10 lbs/1000sf to help suppress weeds that take advantage of sleeping grass.
