There is no need to try and convince people we live in a very dangerous world. Conflicts among nations, tribes, and governments, shootings, civil conflict, genocide, and on and on it goes.

Twenty-four hours a day, we can hear news in real time. We can watch the battles as they happen and see the gory aftermath of mankind's rage. The death and destruction inflicted on one group by another brings no satisfaction or solution to the rage that started the conflict in the first place.

Why is the world so crazy? The answer is pretty simple. It begins with the origin of a kingdom. In the tenth and eleventh chapters of the Book of Genesis,

a man named Nimrod founded the first kingdom mentioned in Scripture.

Babylon was identified as a tower built by people in opposition to God. Their purpose was thwarted when God confused their language and they could no

longer communicate with one another.

Though their efforts were temporarily stopped, the rebellion in their hearts drove them to build kingdoms of their own. For centuries the term Babylonian system refers to man's efforts to build a kingdom for his own purpose and one that only includes gods of his own making.

Beginning in Luke 1:32 is a description of Jesus as the Son of the Highest whose kingdom is eternal. When Jesus went to Galilee it is said, "he preached the gospel (good news) of the kingdom of God" (Mk. 1:14). *Continued on Page 8*

Pet owners should replace their air filters more often due to pet dander getting in and clogging up the system. He further explained that when the external water drip stops dripping, that is a sign of a problem with the unit. Adding bleach to the pipe can keep it flowing.

The following day a technician arrived to check their attic for leaks to make sure the unit was functioning at its best. "The special attention made us feel like family."





Labor Day - The Industrial Revolution



The Industrial Revolution modernized the United States and Canada during the 19th century. As people enjoyed steady employment, they compromised their rights in the workplace. Longer work hours and pay cuts were imposed; U.S. labor groups began protecting themselves by unionizing. In Canada, unions were illegal until 1872, when thousands of Ottawa laborers marched to Prime Minister John MacDonald's home.

That year, Canada wiped the anti-union law from its books and the march became an annual Canadian tradition. In 1882, Toronto labor officials invited an American union leader, Peter J. McGuire, to Toronto's labor celebrations. McGuire was so impressed that he suggested a workers' parade to New York City Central Labor Union. He chose September 5th as the date because it filled

the long void between July 4th and Thanksgiving.

Coincidently, that same year a machinist from Patterson, New Jersey, Matthew McGuire, also proposed a laborers' celebration. On Tuesday, September 5th, 1882, thousands of New York City laborers marched from City Hall to Union Square. They gathered in Reservoir Park for an afternoon of picnics, concerts and speeches, rallying for an eight-hour workday.

Two years later, the Central Labor Union moved the parade to the first Monday in September. They also encouraged all U.S. cities to follow New York's lead and march for the workingman's holiday. For many, the choice was to either spend the day at work or march without pay. That began to change when Oregon became the first state to legalize the Labor Day holiday in 1887. Other states, including New York, soon followed.

It took a political disaster to put Labor Day on the national calendar. In 1894, railway workers in Pullman, Illinois, went on strike to protest wage cuts. President Grover Cleveland faced pressure to end the demonstrations and sent 12,000 federal troops to break the strike and violence erupted.

Two strikers were killed, and Cleveland's harsh methods made headlines. In an attempt to appease the nation's workers, he signed a bill to make Labor Day a federal holiday. Cleveland still lost that year's election.

America's workers continued to gain power through the 1950's when over a third of all labor forces were unionized. Labor Day had become a time to rally workers for safer conditions, fair pay, and benefits. But in the second half of the 20th century, the U.S. labor force diminished, many factories closed, jobs were outsourced to other countries.

Today, workers still parade through blue-collar neighborhoods on Labor Day and speeches unite the ever-dwindling labor force, but the day's true call has quieted. For now, most Americans leisurely enjoy the holiday as summer's last bow.

How Is Your Quality Of Sleep?

Sleep, Part 2 cont. from last month

For those of you who struggle with restless sleep, trouble falling asleep, or if you just aren't waking up feeling well rested, here are a few things to keep in mind:

- 1. Neurotransmitters released in the brain play a role in controlling if we are awake or asleep. This includes histamine, dopamine, serotonin, glutamate, and acetylcholine. Reflexology improves the functioning of the nervous system enabling these neurotransmitters function properly to help improve our sleep.
 - 2. Reflexology can help to reduce pain that is interfering with sleep.
- 3. Stress and tension can keep our bodies in fight-or-flight mode, making it too alert for restful and restorative sleep. Reflexology enables a deep relaxation that helps the body transition out of that flight-or-flight mode.
- 4. Using our circadian rhythm, our bodies start to produce an increasing amount of melatonin, a hormone that makes us sleepy, in the mid-to-late evening. The levels stay elevated until the early morning as the sun comes up. Stress interferes with this process, but when you get the body back into a relaxed state, the natural circadian rhythms can resume.


These are just a few examples of the complex systems of the body, which helps us to get optimal sleep. This is what happens when one area is out of sync; the chain reaction can keep spiraling. It's important to help the body get back to its normal healing mode to help you sleep better.



Amazing Rock Forms at Arches National Park

What Can You See at Arches National Park?

Arches National Park is located five miles north of Moab, UT. You can spend the day driving along the 36-mile road, stopping throughout your journey to see the incredible rock formations and take photos. The park spans 76,519 acres or 119 square miles. Just imagine looking across the vast land with over 2,000 natural stone arches.

Hikers can enjoy many trails leading to the colorful arches. Red sandstones in the park contain iron oxide. The green rocks contain non-oxidized iron. You may see rocks with black, orange, grey or even purple layers. It is amazing to look out over the land and see the rainbow of colors that God has created in the earth.

How Were the Rocks Formed?

Over thousands of years, the earth shifted, and ground levels raised and fell. This process turns fractured rock layers into fins, and fins into arches. Arches are created when potholes near cliff edges grow deeper and wear through the cliff wall. Arches and small honeycomb formations called tafone are formed.

In addition to fracturing, the unique rock formations were created through wind, rain, and snow. Heavy rains erode the rock and carry sediment into the ca xanyons. In the winter, snow melts into cracks within the rocks. The freezing and melting splinters the rock and changes the

Double Arch. This arch is the tallest arch at 112 feet. It is known as a pothole arch, formed by water from above.

Balanced Rock. The 128-foot, 3,577-ton boulder sits atop a 55-foot pedestal.

The Spectacles. The arches are side by side and resemble a pair of glasses.



Once you complete your application (online or in-person), we will mail the card after





If you need to visit an office, please follow these steps to complete the application:

- 1. Learn what types of documents you need to bring to your local office.
- 2. Print and save the online control number shown once you complete the online application.
- 3. Bring the online control number along with the documents to your local office within 45 days to finish your application. Find your local office using our Office Locator at www.ssa.
 - 4. Check in at the kiosk when you arrive.
- 5. Meet with one of our employees to verify the information that you completed online and review documentation.

That's it! You'll receive the card in the mail, usually within 7 - 10 business days.

The Great Florida Outdoors: Vista Gardens

Dr. Robert Norman, Clinical Professor, Dermatology, Nova Southeastern University



The garden surrounding the pavilion is VISTA's Native Plant Landscape, designed in 2020 by Bruce Turley, to model a landscape suitable for moist conditions (in this case, adjacent to our wetland) and still tolerant of dry periods.

During an HRS planning meeting, we identified six species (Monarch, Gulf fritillary, gorgeous Zebra longwing, Sulfur, Swallowtail, etc.) of butterflies nectaring and countless bees and many bumblebees at work. Vicki will point out the Teabush, which usually has an amazing swarm of bees - a present favorite of VISTA's honeybees.

In our effort to "rewild" lawns, reduce

fertilizer use, and conserve water, we model two groundcovers in this Native Plant Landscape, including Hammock twinflower and Creeping sage.

The garden near the Laurel Oak tree is the VISTA's Monarch Waystation Garden. I consider Vicki Kuse, VISTA's Master Gardener, the designer of this garden of water-loving plants. This garden models the Frogfruit aka Matchweed groundcover.

Our Florida Landscape Demonstration Garden, funded by the Florida Wildflower Foundation, is VISTA's Wildflower Garden, also a model native plant landscape designed by Bruce Turley, former president of the Florida Native Plant Society. We are inspiring our neighbors and sparking the beginning of a pollinator corridor in Carrollwood Village with this garden. This garden models Sunshine Mimosa, Frogfruit, and Oblongleaf twinflower groundcovers.

VISTA's Pollinator Garden at the Pond is designed by Janet Stanko and Barbara Kane to attract and support pollinators, including birds. Be sure to walk visitors around the back (east side) so that they see the "stand" of Tropical sage flowering in all three colors - red, white, and pink. Tropical sage is a close/ second favorite of VISTA's honey bees. The garden models Hammock twinflower groundcover.

VISTA has native plant gardens north, south, east and west of our raised vegetable gardens in which our members grow organic food and edible flowers!

"We are so proud of this element; true to the sustainability commitment in our mission statement. Native plants attract pollinators that support successful fruiting and provide beneficial insects to prey on/control non-beneficial pests and reduce the need for applying biological insecticides. For example, parasitoid wasps (that do not sting humans) devour tobacco hornworms and leafroller caterpillars and prevent them from devouring our tomato plants and bean plants respectively."

VISTA Gardens is a truly sustainable community garden. We use no electricity or public water; we are totally off the grid. Solar panels power the garden's deep-well pump, and repurposed

storage tanks supply the garden's gravity-fed water spigots. Donated mulch is applied around the base of plants in the landscape to reduce the growth of weeds and retain water, reducing our water usage.

In large part because of VISTA's collaboration with the Village Food Pantry, annually we compost over 16 tons of inedible fruits, vegetables, and kitchen scraps, saving "waste" from the Hillsborough County waste disposal facilities, and saving the food pantry hundreds of dollars in waste collection fees. The compost, aka Black Gold, we produce is used to amend our 65 raised bed plots, making composting one of VISTA's most successful sustainability efforts.

Our vision is for VISTA Gardens to be the Native Plants Ambassador to our members, neighbors, and the general public by providing quality information about native plants and their importance to wildlife including butterflies, native bees, and other pollinators, humming-birds and other birds, and other wildlife.



a guy in Jerusalem as a procession was going by and found himself surrounded by Roman soldiers. One of them pointed and said, "You there, help him carry his cross." Now we got a common guy on the street that is now involved in the most pitiful moment in history.



It can take three days to die on the cross from blood loss, shock, dehydration, and suffocation. Crucifixions were so common back then that the Romans barely even registered Jesus' death.

Luke 23:32-34: They crucified him there, along with the criminals." Except for his friends and family. They turned out to have the power to transform the entire Roman Empire and change the course of human history.

Profoundly more than any other event over the past 2,000 years, the followers of Jesus will retell his story and spread his message over 1,400 miles from Jerusalem to the imperial capital of Rome. It is one of the largest cities on earth, population 1 million.

It was two and a half times more densely populated than modern Manhattan, but 18 years after the crucifixion, a series of droughts created a food shortage. Over 200,000 tons of grain are needed each year or the Roman people will starve, and one out of five is already on welfare.

Rome's ruler was Emperor Claudius. Disabled and insecure, he was the most powerful man in the Western world. All Emperors had to please the populace by bringing home

the bacon, in a manner of speaking.

But Claudius had to try harder than other rulers to legitimize his rule. Emperor Claudius was regarded as a god, but he still needed the support of his people to stay in power, so he ordered handouts for the poor. However, there was not enough bread to go around.

John 6:35 / Mark 8:1-8 / Matthew 14:13-21: Verses about enough bread to go around.

Riots were part of life in Rome, and it was a way for people to get their message across to their Emperor. The previous Emperor, Caligula, ignored their plea and was subsequently assassinated.

Worried that riots would break out, especially after the crucifixion of Jesus, Claudius knew he could be next. So the best way for him to win over the public was to build.

Eight miles from the city, Claudius started one of the largest engineering projects in the Roman Empire. This mighty Aqueduct carried water to the city of Rome. Carved through 45 miles of countryside, they tunneled through mountains and built bridges of vast structure across the huge amounts of space without dynamite or any kind of modern tools. And yet they were so wellbuilt that 1,500 years later after the end of their civilization, those structures are still standing today.

The Aqueduct was powered by gravity and it needed to drop 1 foot for every 300 feet. If it was too steep, the water would over



flow, and if it was too shallow, it would run dry. Precision engineering was the secret to Roman construction.

A revolution of new building material was needed to mold into hard rock: concrete! Ever since the Romans, we've been living in a concrete age, and the key ingredient to Romans' concrete was volcanic ash. Rome is surrounded by 50 volcanoes and today, two thirds of mankind now lives in buildings made of concrete. The Aqueduct cost equivalently eighty-three billion dollars, ten times more than the Hoover dam.



Imagine the people coming to the Roman Empire for their first time and seeing the massive engineering project. It was advertising Roman power, and it was a Dunndeal. To let everyone know who built this giant monument, the Emperor named it after himself: "Aqua Claudia," the water from Claudius.

It would take 14 years to build and over 400,000 blocks of stone as well as 6,000,000 sq ft. of concrete. Its Aqueducts would deliver 250,000,000 gallons of water a day, enough for 1,300 fountains, 900 basins, and 144 public toilets, which made Rome one of the most advanced cities in the world.

There were six-story high apartment buildings, each with up to 380 residents. Under the roads were sewage systems that swept away 500 tons of waste a day. Rome maintained a police force, a fire brigade, postal service, 30 libraries, 3 theaters, and 80

temples. Rome, the world's first mega city.

Today, for the first time in history, over half of us live in cities. Across the world, there are 21 cities with a population above 10 million, based on the blueprint pioneered by Rome 2,000 years ago. However, Rome was more than just a city, it was an empire that spread its civilization across Europe and beyond.



#9PMRoutine

One of the most common calls for service that the Pasco Sheriff's Office receives is to investigate a car theft or burglary. These are often crimes of opportunity. By eliminating opportunities of car- related crimes, there is less potential to become a victim. PSO encourages a daily habit of removing personal belongings from your car, and locking car and home doors at 9 p.m., known as the #9PMRoutine! Over the past several years, the #9PMRoutine as expanded across the globe, with check-ins coming from all 50 states and countries such as Brazil, Australia and the UK. Other law enforcement agencies have also spread the word of the #9PMRoutine in an effort to lower opportunities for crime in their communities.

When potential criminals cannot quickly enter a car, they'll often keep moving. PSO encourages citizens to always to lock car doors, fully close car windows and secure their keys when parking cars. Easy access to car keys is the simplest way a criminal can steal a car. Never leave keys inside a car, even for a minute or two.. Push-to-start cars don't require suspects to know where the key is, if its tucked away inside a car, such as a glove box or center console.

Leaving your car unlocked with a garage door opener inside can also give potential criminals access to your home, including your car keys and other valuables. Stolen items from unlocked cars are commonly used in other crimes, which is why its imperative to remove personal belongings and valuables every time you park your car.

Citizens can do quite a bit to minimize the risk of car burglaries and thefts. When parking, park leave your car in a locked garage or a lit driveway if possible. Avoid parking in isolated and poorly-lit areas with shadows and cover from larger vehicles, fences or plants. Take a moment to do a quick check of nearby surroundings.

If you see something, say something! Report suspicious activity in your neighborhood to law enforcement immediately. Provide the address, block number or location in a parking lot. Provide as much information as possible to identify the suspect, such as the suspect's approximate age, height, weight, hair color and clothing description. If possible, note how the suspect left and in what direction. Additional details that describe the color, make, model, and license plate number are also helpful.

Citizens can help reduce the risk of becoming a victim of car thefts, burglaries or other crimes by completing the simple steps of the #9pmRoutine every night. Encourage those in your neighborhood or home to build good safety habits by locking up and securing their valuables. These simple tasks can have a big impact on crime.



When stored properly, the powder can last for two or more years. Most commercial packets of powder you find will have a two-year expiration range, but they can last longer; that's simply the time when the powder starts losing potency. Always double-check your powder for signs of mold or mildew before using it.

Amounts and Dosage—Consuming moringa powder is proven to be safe, even at higher levels. Daily dosage should be limited to 70 grams (1 teaspoon sprinkled over food)




Moringa encourages the removal of toxins through its support of liver and kidney function. When used environmentally, even the moringa seeds do an amazing job of removing contaminants from water.

Animal studies using Moringa oleifera extract revealed delayed tumor growth and increased life span at a dosage of 500 mg/kg of body weight. Taking 1 tablespoon of moringa powder is the equivalent of eating 1 cup of leafy greens, but if a person is new to increasing their greens, the body needs time to adjust, and every individual has unique body chemistry. It's best to start slow by taking 1 teaspoon if adding to a personal smoothie or single-serving meal, or use 1 tablespoon for a family dish.

Moringa has strong effects that improve blood sugar control and reduce lipids in diabetic patients, so it can be used for prevention as well as management of blood sugar disorders. In a study using Moringa oleifera, Murraya koeingii and Curcuma longa (Ratio 6:3:1), obese patients on the herbal formula showed a 17% reduction in serum glucose, 16.43% reduction in triglycerides and 12.6% improvement in LDL/HDL ratios. Whatever amount you decide is right for you, the best results are achieved by using moringa regularly.


