observe Passover, the Jewish holy season that celebrates the Hebrews' release from slavery.

After the Passover supper, Jesus was arrested, and on what is now called Good Friday, he was crucified. Two days later, he rose from the dead. Those of Jewish origin were the first to celebrate the resurrection, likely as a new facet of the Passover festival. In fact, the Easter celebration was called "PASCHA." It's derived from the word "PESACH" (the Jewish translation for Passover).

Originally, Easter was celebrated two days after Passover, so it fell on any day of the week, but Easter Wednesday just didn't feel right. In 325 AD, Roman Emperor Constantine and the Council of Nicaea ruled that Easter must fall only on a Sunday, the day when Christ rose from the dead. Easter Sunday would be the first Sunday following the full moon after the spring equinox; it could occur anywhere between March 22nd and April 25th.

These girls have been abused, abandoned, and trafficked, and we just want to show them the love of Jesus", said Cheryl Jackson, Senior Director of At-Risk Kids Ministry. The girls are invited to attend a youth group on Sunday afternoons and are treated to a shopping day in the quaint boutique, which resembles a quality specialty store. The shop is a labor of love for the Boutique Coordinator, Danyelle Schaer. "Walking through the hard, being able to love on these vulnerable girls, and meeting their tangible needs is such a blessing."

The boutique has given over 6000 items to girls in need in the past year. Gently used clothing, new makeup, and toiletries are needed to keep the boutique stocked. Easter's Hope

There is a story in the Bible usually not associated with Easter, but it may be one of the best Easter stories. It is the story of Abraham and the birth of his son Isaac.

Early in Abraham's life, God promised he would be the father of many nations. It was a promise filled with blessings and a hope for the future. Yet Abraham did not have any children, and his wife. Sarah, was unable to conceive.

Abraham waited and waited, but no child ever came. Making matters worse, Abraham's name means "the father of many." It must have been disheartening every time someone used his name and he recalled his lack of children.

He and Sarah finally reached an age where it seemed the promise would be impossible to fulfill. But Abraham would not give up on God's promise. Finally, at the age of 100, Abraham became the father of Isaac. Happy Easter!

How is this an Easter story? St. Paul wrote in Romans 4, "And Abraham's faith did not weaken, even though, at about 100 years of age, he figured his body was as good as dead – and so was Sarah's womb." How was Abraham able to do this? St. Paul wrote, "This happened because Abraham believed in the God who brings the dead back to life and who creates new things out of nothing."

Easter is the celebration of God bringing the dead back to life. In the story of the death and resurrection of Jesus, we find hope, a hope for eternity to be sure, but also a hope for our lives today. You may find yourself in an impossible situation, a situation where all the possibilities seem dead, buried and gone. But, don't give up hope on God's promises for your life. Dead possibilities are no problem for a life-giving God. He brings the dead back to life.

Over 2000 years ago, Jesus was crucified, placed in a tomb and had a stone rolled over the opening. He was considered dead, buried and gone. But on Sunday morning, the stone rolled away, the tomb opened up and he which had been dead walked out alive! God's promise was fulfilled.

I pray you will let the story of Easter strengthen your hope during difficult times. St. Paul wrote, "Even when there was no reason for hope, Abraham kept hoping." The same can be true for us. Happy Easter!


Ask the Lord to help you while you wait. He will give you the grace you need to be patient so that He can bless you with the best.








The Great Florida Outdoors: Nature and Writing, Part 2

Writing can be compared to the three major forms of natural interactions: mutualism commensalism, and parasitism. In writing, mutualism represents the combination of two clear patterns of behavior: a pure line of thought on paper with no detritus, and a pure comprehension by the reader. This is the relationship we strive for, however idealistic.

The writer, even with the best intentions, and the finest editor, has good and bad days. And the reader has similar peaks and troughs. But the partnership, the symbiosis, is the goal. As with lichen, a cohabitation of algae and fungus, the symbiosis can be close to ideal. The fungus provides plant form and absorbs water and minerals while the algae utilizes these raw materials to manufacture food for both. The writer absorbs from the environment and the reader takes the new insight and knowledge inward and also outward into the community. A ripple effect occurs and the beauty of communication shines brightly to replace the darkness.

Parasitism provides the benefit of one and is detrimental to the other, like a tick on a dog.

Commensalism is when one benefits and the other gains no benefit, represented by creatures like the remora which follow sharks and eat their leftovers. When the natural balance is out of control, as with pathological perceptions dictated by propaganda to a vulnerable ear, or fertile prose offered to a barren and unwilling listener, parasitism or commensalism is the rule and the byproducts of mutualism disappear.

A writer who tunes into the rhythm of the environment must be aware of the clearness which is being attempted in the writing. The laws of nature dictate the need for clarity and viability without stagnation. Wipe away the dirty windshield of unclear, parasitic prose and a chance for a new vision appears!

The writer's freedom, survival, sustenance, and contributions will be based, at least partially, on the mutualism created and respect paid to the naturally curative powers of clear communication. The true test is to transfer knowledge successfully. If a direct wisdom-transfer does not occur, the reader and writer both will be disappointed, and the reader may not appoint the writer to the highest position of creative leadership.

In summary, the truth of nature will stand the test of time. The epiphany and true excitement

of writing are enhanced when the laws of nature are followed with due humility.



This designation indicates that the agency has taken the proactive steps needed to train employees to recognize the signs of human trafficking and have been given the resources to report the indications to law enforcement.

"I applaud Staff Development Manager Alicia Albanese and her staff for putting in the hard work to ensure that all 229 active employees of the tax collector's office have been trained to recognize the red flags of this crime," Tax Collector Mike Fasano states. "Utilizing curriculum created by the Florida Alliance to End Human Trafficking we

have taken the positive steps needed to make sure our employees are fully trained in spotting human trafficking in its many forms."

"Ending the scourge of human trafficking requires our community to be aware and engaged," remarks Sheriff Chris Nocco. "The Pasco Sheriff's Office applauds our partner, the Pasco County Tax Collector's Office, for their 100% completion in human trafficking awareness which will continue to assist law enforcement as we seek to end this heinous crime."

Slam the Scam: How to Spot **Government Imposters**

Do you know how to spot a government imposter scam? Knowing how to identify potential scammers will help safeguard your personal information.

There are common elements to many of these scams. Scammers often exploit fears and threaten you with arrest or legal action. Scammers also pose as Social Security or other government employees and claim there's a problem with your Social Security number (SSN) or your benefits. They may even claim your SSN is linked to a crime.

When you identify a potential scammer:

- Hang up right away or ignore the message.
- · Never give personal information or money.
- · Report the scam immediately to our Office of the Inspector General at oig.ssa.gov/scam-aware ness/report-the-scam.

If you owe money to Social Security, we'll mail

you a letter with payment options and appeal rights. We only accept payments electronically through Pay.gov, Online Bill Pay, or physically by check or money order through our offices. We will never do the following:

- Threaten you with arrest or legal action because you don't agree to pay us money immediately.
- Promise a benefit increase in exchange for money.
- Ask you to send us gift cards, prepaid debit cards, wire transfers, internet currency, cryptocurrency, or cash through the U.S. mail.

Scammers continue to evolve and find new ways to steal your money and personal information. Please stay vigilant and help raise awareness about Social Security-related scams and other government imposter scams. For more information on scams, please visit www.ssa.gov/scam.

Tell your friends and family about government imposter scams. Let them know they don't have to be embarrassed to report if they shared personal financial information or suffered a financial loss. The important thing is to report the scam right away.





Easter And What It Has To Do With A Bunny

Around the same time, Christians began one of the first recorded rituals of the modern Easter celebration—the lighting of the Paschal candle. Its flame is a reminder of Christ's resurrection—light out of darkness. As Christianity spread throughout Europe, different pagan customs blended into the holidays. In fact, the actual word "Easter" may have come from "Ēostre," the Goddess of spring and fertility, which brings us to the Easter egg.

Eggs have been a mythological symbol of birth for thousands of years. Christians adopted the egg as an Easter custom sometime around the 13th century. The yolk inside a shell represented Christ emerging from the tomb. Eggs were painted red, representing the blood Christ

shed from the cross.



The colorful Easter egg soon hatched its own traditions. A popular one was egg rolling. In 1876, Congress prohibited kids from playing on the Capitol grounds, so President Rutherford B. Hayes opened the White House lawn to the little rollers. Thereafter, the White House Easter Egg Roll became a tradition.

So, when did that Easter Bunny hop onto the

scene? The fertile rabbit has long been a symbol of new life in European pagan celebrations.

Beginning around the 16th century, parents told children that if they behaved, on the eve of Easter, the Osterhase (the name given in Germany to the Easter Bunny) would come and lay colorful eggs, so the children built nests in their homes to entice the rabbit to visit.

Thus began the custom of the Easter egg hunt and the Easter basket. To help fill out those baskets, 19th century European chocolatiers began making egg-shaped chocolates, and the sweet trend spread throughout the world. Today, billions of dollars are spent each year on Easter candy.


Easter is a joyful day when Christians celebrate Jesus Christ's resurrection. It witnesses the immense power of God Himself and the belief that God exists. Only He who created life can resurrect it after death






