What is Truth?

In the Garden of Gethsemane, hours before His arrest, Jesus prayed for the disciples: "Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth." John 17:17 A little later, when questioned by Pilate, Jesus replied that He'd come into the world to testify to the truth. This prompted Pilate's philosophical question that people today still ask: "What is truth?" John 18:37-38 says, "'You are a king, then!' said Pilate. Jesus answered, 'You are right in saying I am a king. In fact, for this reason I was born, and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone on the side of truth listens to me.' 'What is truth?' Pilate asked. With this he went out again to the Jews and said. 'I find no basis for a charge against him."

The meaning of the word corresponds to what actually is, not what we feel or wish were true. We may avoid truth—or water it down or cover it up because it can be uncomfortable to expose weakness or bring wrongdoing into the light.

Truth is so important its's mentioned almost 200 times in Scripture. In fact, in chapters 17 & 18 of John, which describe Jesus' last hours before the crucifixion, the word is mentioned six times. Here's why it matters so much: When truth loses its supreme position in our life, everything begins to crumble.

pdLIFE Non–Profit Encouraging People with Parkinson's to Become PD Fighting Warriors!

Parkinson's Disease is a degenerative progressive brain disorder associated with the loss of dopamine producing nerve cells (neurons) deep inside the brain. There is NO cure for Parkinson's. You will not die from the disease, however, you can die with complications associated with Parkinson's. Alarming statics show that every six minutes another person is diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease. The disease starts with motor symptoms of slight tremors, stiffness or slowing

of movement and poor balance and coordination. Over time, the non-motor symptoms become more devastating and challenging for people with Parkinson's such as difficulties with blood pressure and mood changes.

"Parkinson's is no longer an elderly person's disease. It's a disease that impacts people of all ages. Michael J. Fox was diagnosed at age 29", said Valerie Herrero, Board Member of pdLIFE, a non-profit 501-3C organization that serves, supports, and helps unify the Parkinson's community in the Greater Tampa Bay area.

Valerie first became involved as an advocate in the fight against the Parkinson's Disease progression when her 52-year old late husband was diagnosed and heard those infamous 3 words "You have Parkinson's".

Meredith DeFranco, PT, DPT is the Founder/ and the CEO of pdLIFE. As a Doctor of Physical Therapy, Meredith sees patients with Parkinson's Disease at Potentia Therapeutics in South Tampa. She is PWR! Certified and has participated in the National Parkinson's Foundation Allied Team Training, Movement Disorder Society meetings, the World Parkinson Congress, and participated on the UF deep brain stimulation board to assist with the process of screening potential surgical candidates. Over the last two years, Meredith has co-hosted the Parkinson's Foundation Tampa Bay Moving Day Walk to raise money for Parkinson's Foundation.

pdLIFE offers seven free weekly exercise classes and many social events for the Parkinson's community. The pdLIFE mission is to improve the lives of people with Parkinson's and their CarePartners/Givers through Lifestyles, Information, Fitness and Empowerment (LIFE). At this time, there is no cure for Parkinson's but there is HOPE, exercises, procedures and drugs to manage the disease with. To name a few advancements: Deep Brain Stimulation (DBS Brain Pacemaker), Duopa Levodopa Pump, Inbrija oral levodopa inhalers, and express release levodopa carbidopa medication that can be incorporated into daily routines to treat the Parkinson's symptoms.

Scientific trials have proven that exercise improves mobility and helps fight apathy and depression. The more intense the exercise, the better for connecting the body and brain again. However, before starting any new exercise program, always check with your doctors for approval.

pdLIFE is a friend, a family that you can call upon when health situations arise. People with Parkinson's experience good and bad days and pdLIFE is here to help support you through your journey. Through the support groups, people learn the importance of maintaining a sense of life normalcy such as: having date nights, going out with friends for dinner, game nights, movie days, travel, etc. You can still have a very fulfilling life by adapting to the new daily challenges. Some people with Parkinson's have even had awakened new extra-curricular activities such as art, painting and writing books.



Halloween is rapidly approaching, with less than a month before being jump-scared by the neighbors' decorations, loading up on candy, and children screeching. However, it can be entertaining to dress up and act foolish on the last day of this month.

So, why do people hang spiderwebs in their yards for unsuspecting passersby? Why do we sweat like dogs in costumes, anyway?

Halloween dates back approximately two thousand years. The Celts, who lived in Europe, celebrated the New Year on November 1st, the day after our traditional Halloween. They believed that the night before the New Year, the boundary separating the living and the dead began to blur. That night was October 31st, the final day of the year.

The English word "Halloween" comes from "All Hallows' Eve," the evening before All Hallows' Day, which was November 1st, and All



Souls' Day the day afterward. The name originated in the 9th century when people called October 31st "All Hallows' Eve." Then, a form of trick-or-treating began in the Middle Ages. During the next few centuries, traditions commenced, and people carried around jack-o-lanterns, which, back then, were hollowed-out turnips. They were named for night watchmen, who were called "jack-o-lanterns." Nowadays, they are usually fashioned from pumpkins.

Later, during significant times of immigration to the New World, some people recognized the holiday, and others opposed it. Almanacs of colonial and pioneering times indicate that Halloween was not widely celebrated. However, Halloween became popular when Irish and Scottish pilgrims came to North America. Furthermore, American influence spread the holiday around the world.

There is controversy about whether Christians should celebrate Halloween. It has its pros and cons. Dressing in innocuous costumes isn't evil, but Halloween has non-Christian portions. We should seek the Lord's will in everything we do and enjoy the life He has given us.

When life causes you to feel adrift, with no end in sight, emotions be-

come fearful and anxious, oftentimes leading you to make very serious decisions that are devastating. Maybe that's how you feel right now. Are you contemplating a decision that would be a disaster for you and everyone else because you are motivated by hopelessness?

Paul, while on this voyage with many sailors, found that they were ready to jump ship and their decision would ultimately cost them their lives. He began to warn them in the midst of this horrific storm that their decision would only bring them more destruction. How could Paul know this?

Why was Paul so decisive about proper direction in the midst of being adrift? Why was he able to take charge of this seemingly impossible situation and bring hope to 276 desperate, starving, fearful sailors? How could he bring such clarity of thought as he did when he said (verse 22) "there would be no loss of life among them." It was because Paul had heard from the Lord!! This tells me that when we feel adrift, no matter how hard the circumstances, we can look to God and listen for His direction. He can and will speak in the most impossible situations. We need but to ask, believing that He will answer.

Paul contended for God's wisdom, he prayed in intercession (appealing to God on behalf of

Biblical Dating

In 26 years of ministry of working with young people, I would say that dating is definitely at the top of the list of things that gets teens into trouble. In my experience, a majority of the problem is that most parents have no clear direction on the topic of dating and relationships for their teenagers. With a lack of direction combined with so many opinions that have been adopted from a worldly standpoint, our young people are nearly doomed for failure. May I say

to parents that this is a critical topic, one that you cannot avoid dealing with. It needs to start much younger than what most would think.

Biblical dating is not the most popular topic, and for many, it will be classified as "old fashioned" and "outdated." I firmly believe that we have an obligation to God to do the best we can to train every child that He has placed into our care at Hope. With that in mind, I take the time every year to have a dating seminar with our 7th-12th graders. For most all of them, it is the first time in their lives that they have looked at boy/girl relationships from a biblical perspective. Let me share with you a few of the principles we teach our children.

1 God placed Adam in the garden. Because of Adam's walk in life, the garden was the most important thing to him. His heart's desire was taking care of the garden. Because of our teens' walk of life, the most important thing for them should be studying, serving the Lord, sports, church activities, etc.

2 God created the exact, perfect, ideal woman for Adam. Adam did not have to go looking for Eve. Adam was faithfully serving the Lord when God brought Eve to Adam. Our teens do not have to go looking for someone. They should faithfully serve the Lord, and in God's timing, He will be faithful to bring the exact, perfect, ideal mate for them.

3 Then the big question. What is the purpose for dating anyway? Is it just to have fun and spend time with someone you enjoy? Or could we be honest and say that dating doesn't normally stay at a friendship level but grows deeper. I believe the purpose for dating is to find a life mate. When two people date, regardless of age, it always leads to a more intimate relationship.

4 Unless your 16 year old son or daughter is ready for marriage, it may be worth rethinking this whole "going out" and "going steady" thing. There is certainly nothing wrong with a bunch of young people spending time together and enjoying each other's fellowship.

As a matter of fact, it's healthy. The youth department of your church is a great avenue for just that. The problem comes when young people want to start singling off, trading rings, and establishing some type of ownership of each other.

Remember, parents, that God has trusted you with that teenager, and if anyone "owns" them, it is you and you alone. This ownership does not change until the day you walk them down the aisle in marriage.

I would encourage every parent to begin at a very early age to train your children in the biblical perspective of dating and proper relationships with those of the opposite sex. There are so many broken lives of young people that could have been saved had parents took a stand and applied some of these simple Bible truths. God's way still works!

The Great Florida Outdoors: Dragonflies Dr. Robert Norman, Clinical Professor, Dermatology, Nova Southeastern University



While reading the book An Immense World by Ed Yong I came to a part about dragonflies and vision. I have an enormous interest in Dragonflies and have probably photographed them over 3000 times.

In one section of the book, Yong describes "critical flicker fusion frequency," also called CFF. If you look at a light that flickers on and off, as the flickering gets faster, there will be a point when the flash merges into a steady glow. CFF is a measure of how quickly a brain can process visual information. It's like the frame rate of the movie playing inside an animal's head when all the static images blend into the illusion of continuous motion. In good light, human CFF is around 60 frames per second.

Dragonflies, honeybees and flies have CFF's between 200 and 350. A dragonfly doesn't see as much detail as a human can, but its eyes and brain are extremely sensitive to motion. They can detect movements separated by 1/300th of a second! To a dragonfly, a movie might look like a series of still pictures. Dragonflies have binocular vision, so they can judge distances.

Dragonflies can see in all 360 degrees around it and nearly 80 percent of the insect's brain is dedicated to its sight.

Predatory insects like dragonflies have large high resolution eyes with distinctive acute zones. As they pursue their targets, they turn their heads to keep the prey within the sharpest part of


We humans have what's known as tri-chromatic vision, which means we see colours as a combination of red, blue and green. This is thanks to three different types of light-sensitive proteins in our eyes, called opsins. We are not alone: di-, tri- and tetra-chromatic vision is de rigueur in the animal world, from mammals to birds and insects. Enter the dragonfly. A study of 12 dragonfly species has found that each one has no fewer than 11, and some a whopping 30, different visual opsins.



a loved one may be suffering from domestic abuse, start an open conversation to address it. Survivors want to be heard, so listen without judgment and validate their feelings and experience. Ask how you can best support their decision, especially if you are concerned for their safety. Working with local resources, victims can create a personal safety plan before taking action to leave an abusive situation. If a situation ever becomes an emergency, call 9-1-1 immediately.

PSO's Victim Advocates offer a wide array of services for survivors, and ensure that a victim's rights are upheld throughout the investigative and judicial processes. PSO's Victim Advocates may also act as a liaison on a survivor's behalf, if they wish. Victim Advocates help survivors evaluate and navigate available resources, such as legal action, arranging immediate shelter for a safe place to stay, medical appointments or legal meetings.

Other resources include Sunrise of Pasco County, Inc., a local domestic and sexual violence center that provides free services like counseling, advocacy and support services to survivors of domestic and sexual violence. Those experiencing domestic abuse often lack a safe place to stay to break the cycle of abuse, and staying with family or a friend may not be the safest option if the abuser knows where to find the victim. Sunrise provides confidential housing temporarily for those in these situations. All services provided by Sunrise are free of charge and confidential. The National Domestic Violence Hotline, which can be reached at 800-799-7233, is a free and confidential resource, providing services by phone and online chat with access to over 200 languages.
